Federal, State, and local fair housing laws grant all persons equal opportunity in the sale, rental, insurance, and financing of housing. Under these laws it is unlawful to deny or treat persons differently based on their membership in one or more of the following classes: race, color, sex, national origin/ancestry, religion, age, disability, marital status, income, sexual orientation, or family status. This seminar will provide an overview of the State, Federal, and local fair housing laws and discuss how rental property practices may be implemented to be in compliance with the laws.
