**MINUTES**

I. The April 6, 2016 Police & Fire Commission Meeting was called to order at 2:50 p.m. by Commission President Donohoo in the Hearing Room at Franklin City Hall. Members present were Commissioners Donohoo, Lindner, and Nelson. Commissioners Maher-Johnson was excused. Commissioner Sass was absent. Human Resources Coordinator Zahn was also in attendance.

II. Approval of the Minutes from 12/30/2015.

Motion by Commissioner Lindner and seconded by Commissioner Nelson to approve the minutes from 12/30/2015 as written. Motion Carried: Ayes – All.

III. Discipline Hearing-a discipline hearing concerning charges against former City of Franklin Police Officer Steven Rabinovich.

Commission President Donohoo explained that Rabinovich was terminated due to residency requirements and is now back from military duty. He expects the charges to be dismissed but has not gotten confirmation back from Rabinovich's attorney.

IV. Correspondence from Rachel Suzanne Rivera dela Rosa

Commission President Donohoo allowed members to read the original letter he received from her. No action was taken at this time.

V. Proposed Changes to the Commission's Disciplinary Procedure

Commission President Donohoo explained he had not had time to put together his suggested changes to the procedures and this item will have to be discussed at the next meeting.

VI. Hiring of Firefighter/EMT persons-The Police and Fire Commission may enter closed session pursuant to sec. 19.85(1)(c) to consider employment of Firefighter/EMT candidates. Specific items to be discussed include the interviewing of numerous applicants for Firefighter/EMT and determining which applicants will be passed on for further consideration in the hiring process. The Commission may then reconvene into open session at the same place thereafter to act on such matters discussed in the closed session as it deems appropriate and to continue the meeting

Motion by Commissioner Lindner and seconded by Commissioner Nelson that candidates 1, 3, 7, 10, 12, 13, 15, 19, and 20 are passed on. There is no candidate #9. Candidate #14 had to cancel his interview. Candidates 2, 4, 5, 6, 8, 11, 16, 17, and 18 are not passed on for further consideration. Motion Carried: Ayes – All.
