Motion made by Board Member Specht, seconded by Board Member Bartnicki to direct DPW to remove millings and return to previous condition. Motion carried.

REQUEST FOR PARKING
RESTRICTIONS ON W. CENTRAL
AVENUE FROM S. 27TH STREET
TO S. 31ST STREET

Motion made by Alderman Taylor, seconded by Board Member Specht to recommend to Common Council to restrict parking on south side of Central Avenue from S. 27th Street to S. 31st Street and encourage restaurant owner to develop shared parking options with hotel to the south. We did not discuss length of no parking, thus this recommendation is for the whole length. Chairman requests Council to consider the length of parking independent of BPW. Motion carried.
