



# Project Brief

## S. 27th Street (Milwaukee County) Project Information

### About The Project

The project stretches approximately 2.3 miles from south of W. Drexel Ave. to north of W. College Ave., in the cities of Franklin and Oak Creek in Milwaukee County.

Construction began in spring 2015 and is scheduled to be completed in fall 2016.



As part of the WIS 241 (S. 27th Street) reconstruction project, the following upcoming project work and closures are scheduled for the next phase of this project:

### North segment traffic switch on S. 27th Street scheduled for week of November 16:

- WIS 241 northbound traffic from just south of Drexel Avenue to just south of College Avenue is scheduled to be shifted to the newly paved WIS 241 NB mainline. (See map for details)

### Upcoming nighttime closure scheduled the week of November 16:

Crews are working to complete storm sewer operations at College Avenue and S. 27th Street and will require closures Wednesday evening through Thursday morning, November 18 - 19 from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m.


- Access to westbound College Avenue from northbound and southbound S. 27th Street will be closed to traffic.
- Access to northbound S. 27th Street from westbound College Avenue will be closed to traffic.

**Detour:** Travelers are encouraged to use an alternate route to get around the closures.
