Greetings from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) has resumed construction of WIS 241 (S. 27th Street). As part of the reconstruction project, the following upcoming project work and closures are scheduled for the next phase of this project.

All work is weather dependent and subject to change!

Upcoming project work the week of March 28:

Monday and Tuesday, March 28-29 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.:

- Crews are preparing to install storm sewer and will be required to close westbound Drexel Avenue just west of S. 27th Street. Additionally, Drexel Avenue will be closed eastbound to northbound S. 27th Street, Tuesday, March 29.
- **Alternate Route:** Travelers should consider using Rawson Avenue to get around the closure.

Tuesday, March 29:

- Crews are preparing to switch eastbound traffic on Rawson Avenue to the newly constructed westbound lanes, just east and west of S. 27th Street, while crews reconstruct the eastbound lanes. (See map for details)

Wednesday, March 30:

- Crews are preparing to switch eastbound traffic on Drexel Avenue to the newly constructed westbound lanes, just east and west of S. 27th Street, while crews reconstruct the eastbound lanes. (See map for details)
