Greetings from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation

The WIS 241 (S. 27th Street) reconstruction is well underway! Listed below are construction and schedule updates, road closures, and alternate route options.

Project work continues with:

- Utility work along the corridor
- Temporary traffic signal installation
- Grading and excavating
- Storm sewer installation
- Concrete sawing
- Majority of median lanes closed from south of Drexel to north of College avenues
- Construction began on Riverwood Boulevard, W. Sycamore Street/Avenue, Drexel, Rawson and College avenues.

Partial Traffic Switch

A partial traffic switch of WIS 241 northbound lanes to WIS 241 southbound lanes (Minnesota Avenue to just south of Drexel Avenue) is scheduled for mid-June. A project brief with detailed information regarding the traffic switch will be communicated the week of June 8, 2015.

Upcoming nighttime closure scheduled Wednesday, June 3, 2015:

WIS 241 northbound lanes at Drexel Avenue are scheduled to close Wednesday, June 3, from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. for utility work at the intersection of Drexel Avenue and WIS 241 (S. 27th Street). Motorists should use Ryan Road as their alternate route to get around the closure (see map for details).
