



PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is resurfacing approximately 3 miles of WIS 100 between S. 60th Street and W. St. Martins Road. The project is scheduled to be completed by late fall 2025.

Project Scope

The following work is scheduled to take place as part of this project:

- Replacing concrete pavement
- Upgrading storm sewer systems
- Installing updated traffic signals at WIS 36 (Loomis Road), 76th Street and 60th Street
- Updating pavement markings and signs
- Adding a new multi-use path along the length of the project



Traffic Impacts

- Lane closures are scheduled to begin in late March at the WIS 36 (Loomis Road) and WIS 100 intersection
- WIS 100 will be closed to non-local traffic from 60th Street to Puetz Road from mid-April to fall 2025
- The intersection of WIS 100 and Puetz Road is scheduled to close in fall 2025 for reconstruction

Detour

- ➔ Motorists are encouraged to use WIS 241 (27th Street), County BB (Rawson Avenue), and WIS 36 (Loomis Road) to get around the closure

Access to residences and businesses will be maintained.

Please note that short-term driveway closures are expected for the removal and paving of driveway approaches and the roadway. Contractors will contact property owners at least 48 hours prior to this work.

All work is weather dependent and subject to change.
