TO: City of Franklin Residents and Constituents

SUBJECT: 2024 Property Tax Bill Lottery Credits

The Wisconsin Department of Revenue put out a press release on December 18, 2024 reminding residents to check their property tax bill to ensure the Lottery and Gaming Credit is applied (if applicable). This credit provides property tax relief to taxpayers who qualify and is displayed as a reduction of property taxes due on the tax bill. The City of Franklin follows extensive procedures to ensure that all residents who have an application on file received the Lottery and Gaming Credit for 2024.

TO QUALIFY:

- 1. You must be a Wisconsin resident
- You must own a dwelling and use it as your <u>PRIMARY</u> residents as of the January 1 certification date of the year the property taxes are levied <u>(in this case January 1, 2024)</u>

NOTE: If an owner is temporarily absent, typically for a period no longer than **SIX months, the primary residence is the home where the owner returns.

YOU CANNOT CLAIM THE LOTTERY AND GAMING CREDIT ON BUSINESS PROPERTY, RENTAL UNITS, VACANT LAND, GARAGES, OR OTHER PROPERTY THAT IS NOT THE OWNERS PRIMARY RESIDENCE.

HOW TO APPLY:

- 1. Apply online: https://ww2.revenue.wi.gov/VaultPublic/lc/interview.html
- 2. City Hall: At the Treasury Department, staff will have available applications to fill out. Once this is filled out, the lottery and gaming credit will be applied to your tax bill.
- 3. WI Department of Revenue website: You may mail a copy of your 2024 or 2025 Lottery and Gaming Credit application to City Hall or e-mail it to the Director of Finance, Danielle Brown.
