CITY OF FRANKLIN BOARD OF WATER COMMISSIONERS JANUARY 21, 2025 MEETING MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL:

The regular meeting of the Franklin Board of Water Commissioners was held on January 21, 2025, and called to order at 5:16 p.m. by President Gary Grobner in the Hearing Room, Franklin City Hall, 9229 W. Loomis Road, Franklin, Wisconsin.

<u>UNFINISHED BUSINESS</u> LOVERS LANE WATER TOWER & WATER MAIN PROJECT UPDATE:

Superintendent Beardsley indicated water tower pedestal is done. Tank is done but still not attached. It will get painted and attached in spring. There are 3 contracts—A, B & C. Contract A is complete. Contract B is the tank and some water main onsite, which is in progress. Contract C is estimated to be complete by end of March.

- DPW CAMPUS UTILITIES: Superintendent Beardsley informed Board most of project is sewer main but does have 800 feet of water main. Equipment is onsite and work will probably start this week.
- 2025 PROPOSED BUDGET: Director of Finance & Treasurer Brown reviewed & discussed proposed budget, including an amendment.

Eveyone in attendance went around the room and introduced themselves.

Commissioner Kresovic moved to approve the minutes of the December 17, 2024 regular meeting. Seconded by Commissioner Richard. All voted Aye; motion carried.

Commissioner Kresovic moved to approve the Vouchers for January, 2025, in the amount of \$745,318.22. Seconded by Commissioner Richard. All voted Aye; motion carried.

Superintendent Beardsley summarized water service leaks that were found and repaired that were discovered during water leak study done in November/December. Informed Board of water loss discovery at two condominium buildings. Meters were registering usage but not sending signals and system was underestimating quarterly bills; will be corrected for 1st quarter 2025.

Commissioner Kresovic moved to proceed with Change Order 1 for the water tower transmission main Contract C project to increase the contract price by \$11,193.80 to Vinton Constructoin Co. Seconded by Commissioner Richard. All voted Aye; motion carried.
