10/14/2024

Retail Theft 6701 S 27 St - Walmart

On Monday, 10/14/24, at 1416 hours, 2 subjects out of Milwaukee were taken into custody for Retail Theft. This occurred after they attempted to leave the store with unpaid merchandise valued at \$127.45. They were booked, cited, and released.

On Monday, 10/14/24, officers responded to a 2-vehicle crash on the 6500 Blk of S Lovers Lane Rd. No injuries were reported.

On Tuesday, 10/15/24, at 0929 hours, a subject was taken into custody for Retail Theft and Trespassing. This occurred after he attempted to leave the store with unpaid merchandise valued at \$222.15. He had previously been trespassed from the store. He was booked, cited, and released.

After being taken to County Jail, a body scan revealed the subject had been concealing multiple meth pipes. Charges were referred to the District Attorney's office for Possession of Contraband in a Penal Institute.

On Sunday, 10/20/24, at approximately 1356 hours, a subject out of Oak Creek was taken into custody for Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated- 1st offense.
