CITY OF FRANKLIN'S COMMON COUNCIL HOLDS SPECIAL ELECTION FOR
FIRST DISTRICT ALDERMANIC POSITION

FRANKLIN Wis., (July 10, 2024) – In a special election held on July 9, 2024, the city of Franklin's Common Council elected Jon Peccarelli as alderman for the First District. The election was held to replace Ed Holpfer who resigned from the position effective June 30, 2024.

Peccarelli is a 47-year resident of Franklin, and in his letter of interest stated he "looks forward to having a positive impact in the community."

Peccarelli's term, along with District 2 Michelle Eichmann and District 5 Mike Barber, will expire on April 14, 2025. The alderperson elected at the spring election on April 1 will be sworn in to begin a three-year term.

"We appreciate the years of service Ed gave to the city, and are grateful for the citizens who expressed interest in filling the vacancy. I was impressed with Jon during the Common Council meeting and look forward to collaborating with him to elevate the growth in both the First District and our community," said Mayor John Nelson.

Peccarelli was sworn in on July 9.
