**FOURTH OF JULY PARADE DETAILS ANNOUNCED BY THE CITY OF FRANKLIN**

FRANKLIN, WI., (June 20, 2024) – Fourth of July is one of the most celebrated holidays and one our community looks forward to every year. I am happy to report that South Loomis Road will once again be the main route for the city's Fourth of July parade. As in years past, on Thursday, July 4 the children's parade will begin at 10:30 a.m. and the main parade at 11 a.m., and start on the corner of West Forest Hill and South Loomis Road, head east to West Drexel Avenue and on to the destination: Lions Legend Park.

Set-up for the parade can begin on **Wednesday, July 3 at noon**. Final construction on South Loomis Road will be completed the morning of July 3<sup>rd</sup>, so any chairs, tents, tables, flags, and other items that are roped off on the grass, sidewalk and median areas before noon on July 3<sup>rd</sup> will be removed.
